INSURANCE

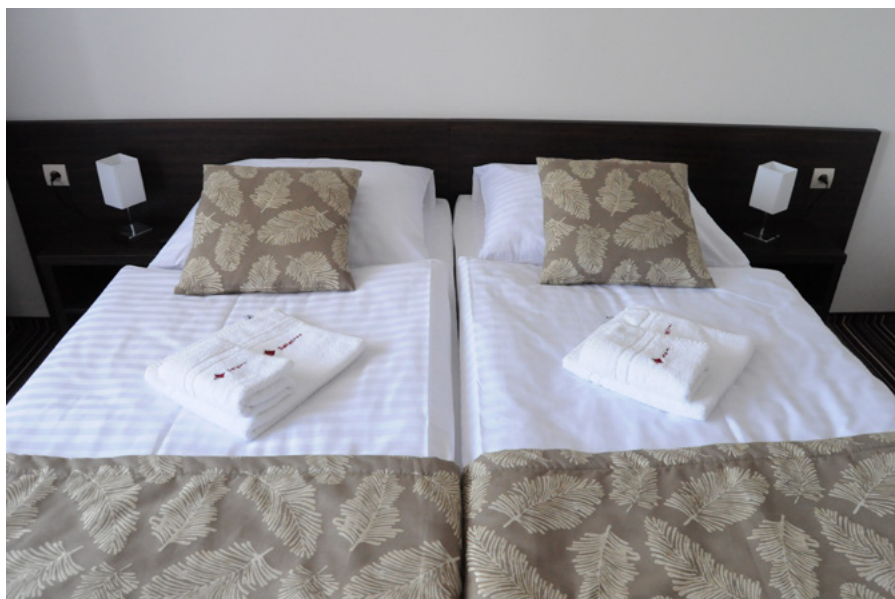
A liability and health insurance is obligatory for each participant. IKGA Slovakia cannot be held liable for any damage to persons or materials during the event.

Venue of the seminar is Poprad, Hotel Satel***. The price includes accommodation, buffet breakfast, lunch, dinner, training fee, free beer, wine and soft drinks at the Sayonara party. The mandatory IKGA fee in the amount of 10 € (athletes only) must be collected in advance by the Shibuchō/representative and handed over at hotel check-in.

dinner served at 8 pm.

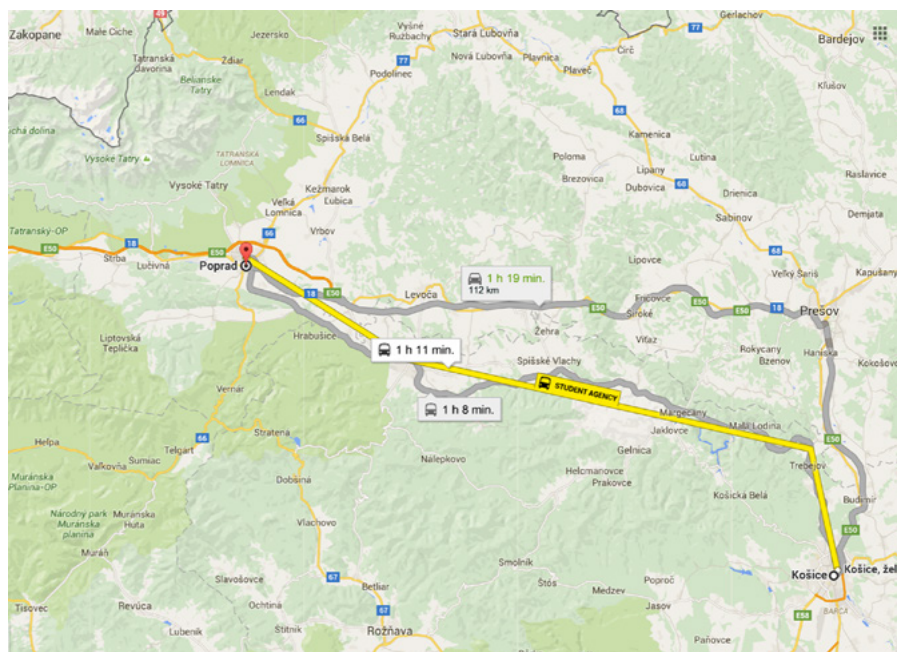
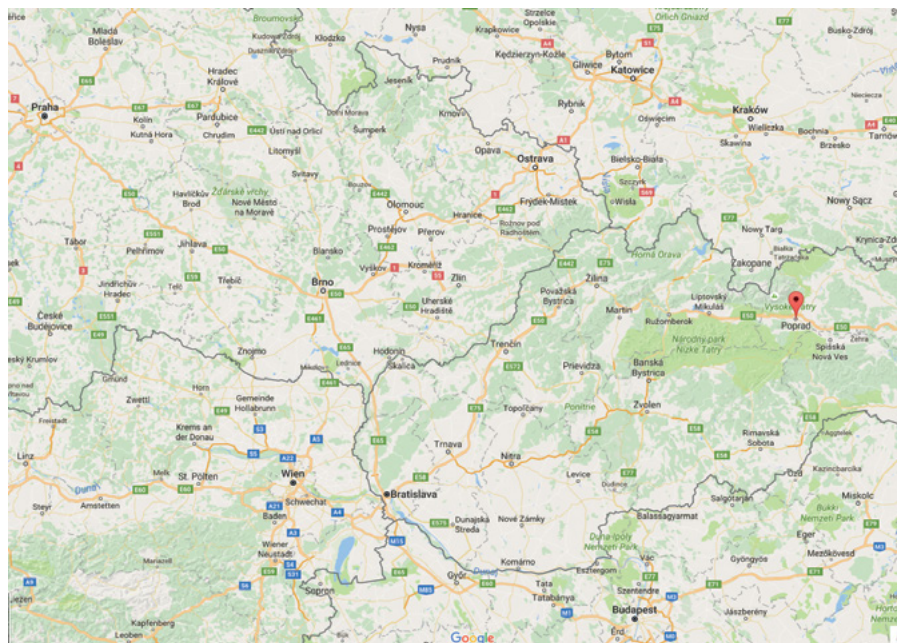
Tuesday – Thursday: training from 10–12 am and from 4–6 pm everybody;

TRANSPORT

The best possibility to reach Poprad is flying directly to Poprad–Tatry or to Košice which has a direct connection to London, Vienna, Bratislava, Prague, Kiev, Warsaw, Bristol, Istanbul and Doncaster. You could take a train directly from Košice to Poprad. It takes approximately 70 minutes and the train leaves every 1 hour from Košice. In Poprad, Hotel Satel is 5 minutes walking distance from the train station.

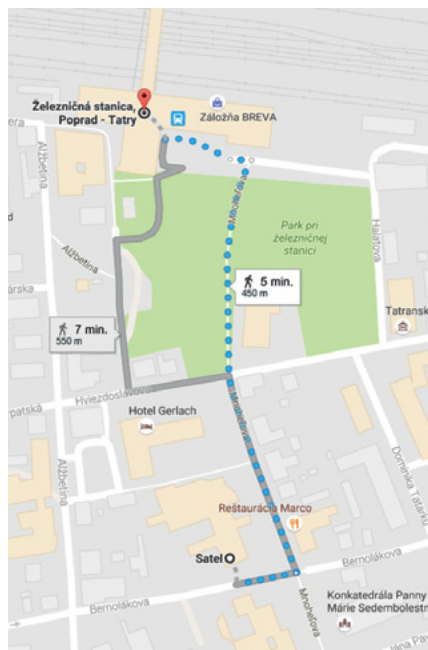

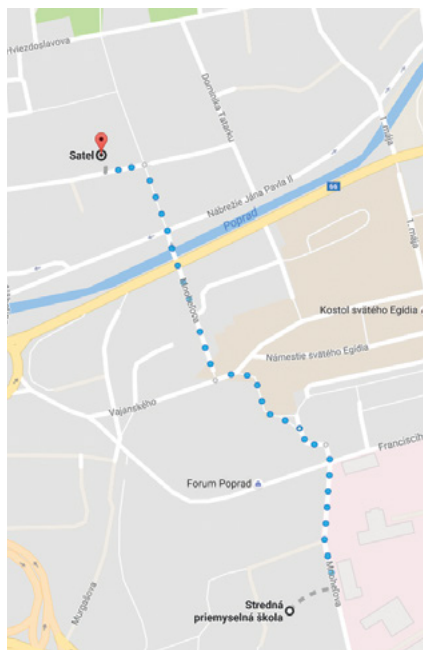

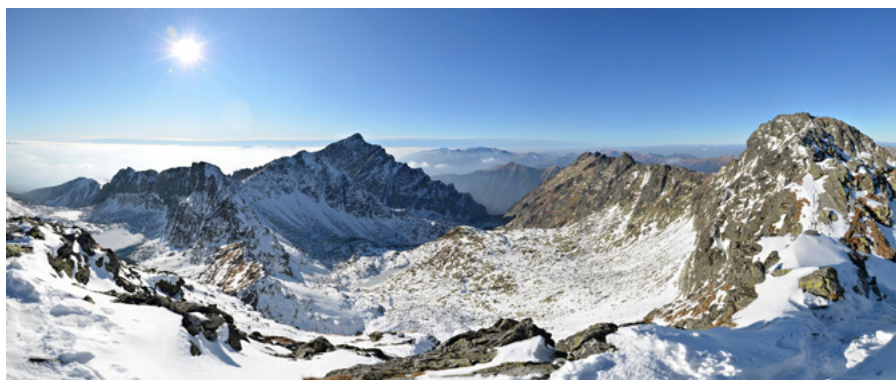
route from the train station
